St Catherine's Hospice (Promotions) Ltd Lottery: Full Terms and Conditions: (LO0225):

- 1. These Terms and Conditions are the Lottery Rules. By entering the lottery, entrants agree to be bound by these rules.
- 2. This lottery is being promoted by and on behalf of St Catherines Hospice (Promotions) Ltd
- 3. For the purpose of the Gambling Act 2005, this lottery is defined as a 'Society Lottery.'
- 4. This lottery is licensed by the Gambling Commission (www.gamblingcommission.gov.uk)
- 5. To enter the lottery, you must be a UK resident aged 18 (eighteen) or over. In the event of participation and of confirmation of underage, all stake money shall be returned, and no winnings shall be paid.
- There will be £1550 cash prizes every week (which includes £250 rollover* *maximum prize of £10,000) although additional prizes could be offered from time to time.
